State of Georgia COVID-19 Summer Camp Guidelines

- 1. Display a sign at any entrances to telling campers/parents that they cannot enter if they have COVID-19 or if they have been in contact with someone who has COVID sometime during the last 14 days.
- 2. Display a sign or poster at any entrance that reminds patrons that your site has
 - a) enhanced sanitation procedures
 - b) practices social distancing (Six Feet)
 - c) tests for elevated temperatures (cannot be 100.4 Fahrenheit or above)
- **3.** Remove campers or staffers that become symptomatic.
- **4.** Sign campers in and out in a contactless manner.
- **5**. Stagger campers while waiting for temperature checks when possible.
- **6.** Have campers use hand sanitizers as they enter the camp site.
- **7.** Do not invite or have "guest speakers" or other outsiders into the camp area.
- **8.** Do not go on camp field trips.
- **9.** Train staffers about all new COVID guidelines.
- **10**. Designate a sick area for campers or staffers to go to while waiting to go home.
- **11.** Limit the number of campers and staff to a total of 20 per space.
- **12.** Keep the same staff with the same campers all week.
- **13.** Do not combine two sets of campers together for an activity.
- **14.** Create a special spot for each camper to put lunchboxes and other belongings.
- **15.** Don't use a room, a piece of equipment, or supplies that cannot be sanitized.
- **16.** A set of campers should go to bathroom breaks, water fountains, or other rooms separate from other set of campers.
- **17.** Clean the camp equipment after each group use.
- **18.** Administrators visit and observe camps to make sure guidelines are followed.
- **19.** No swimming.
- **20.** Keep other building visitors separated from campers.

- **21.** Provide hand sanitizing stations.
- **22.** Have campers sanitize after visiting restroom and after eating.
- **23.** Camper snacks and lunches should be sealed and labeled.
- **24.** Eat separately.
- **25.** Wear gloves when helping campers open their food packaging.
- **26.** Do not transport campers in vans or other vehicles.
- **27.** Clean and sanitize restrooms and frequently touched surfaces two times during camp hours.
- **28.** Give personal protective equipment (PPE) to campers and staffers as appropriate.
